<u>Michael Craig</u> - Craig's environmental efforts have earned Charles Drew Transition Center the title of a Michigan Green School and in 2015 he was named the Michigan Educator of the Year.

<u>Cody Youth Ambassadors</u> - A student group of Cody High School's Detroit Institute of Technology, made up of young leaders who are bringing sustainable change to their high school and the surrounding community.
